## **Fictional Characters & Holiday Icons**

**Think about:** costume, colour, mood, symbolism

- 🎃 **Jack Skellington** – Halloween / Christmas crossover
- 🎅 **Santa Claus** – Christmas celebrations
- 🐰 **The Easter Bunny** – Easter
- 🕒 **Father Time** – New Year
- 📷 **Krampus** – Winter festivals
- 🌲 **The Grinch** – Anti-celebration twist
- 🎁 **Festive Mascot** – Invent your own holiday icon

**Design focus:** exaggerated shapes, festive props, strong silhouettes

## **Mythology, Folklore & Ancient Celebrations**

**Think about:** gods, spirits, rituals, storytelling

- 🍷 **Dionysus / Bacchus** – Festivals, music, wine
- 🌿 **The Green Man** – Spring and rebirth
- 🌞 **Sun Deity** – Solstice celebrations
- 🍂 **Chang'e** – Mid-Autumn Festival
- 🗡️ **Anansi** – Festival storytelling traditions
- 🌸 **Oshun** – Love, fertility, joy

**Design focus:** symbolic objects, flowing shapes, patterned costumes

## **Carnivals, Parades & Performance**

**Think about:** movement, masks, rhythm, excitement

- 🎭 **Venetian Masked Performer** – Carnival of Venice
- 🎶 **Samba Dancer** – Rio Carnival
- 🎪 **Carnival King or Queen** – Caribbean Carnival
- 🥁 **Drummer or Parade Leader** – Street festivals
- 🐉 **Dragon Dancer** – Lunar New Year

**Design focus:** bold colours, texture, dynamic poses

## Cultural & Religious Celebrations

**Think about:** meaning, respect, tradition

- 🕯️ **Diwali Celebrant** – Festival of Lights
- 🏠 **Eid Celebrant** – Eid al-Fitr
- 🔦 **Hanukkah Celebrant**
- 🏮 **Ramadan Lantern Bearer**
- 🎭 **Traditional Festival Performer** – Choose a culture to research

**Design focus:** pattern, colour symbolism, cultural research

## Life Events & Personal Celebrations

**Think about:** emotion, pride, growth

- **Bride / Groom** – Wedding celebrations
- **Quinceañera** – Coming-of-age celebration
- **Graduate** – Achievement and success
- **Naming Ceremony Character**
- 🏆 **Victory Champion** – Sports or personal success

**Design focus:** facial expression, body language, meaningful props
